Dr. Pramod Kumar Singh welcomed the trainees and gave an outline of the objectives of the Workshop and expected outcomes.





- g. This program helped to acquaint the participants with latest resources, websites, tools and guidelines which can help to improve the quality of publications.

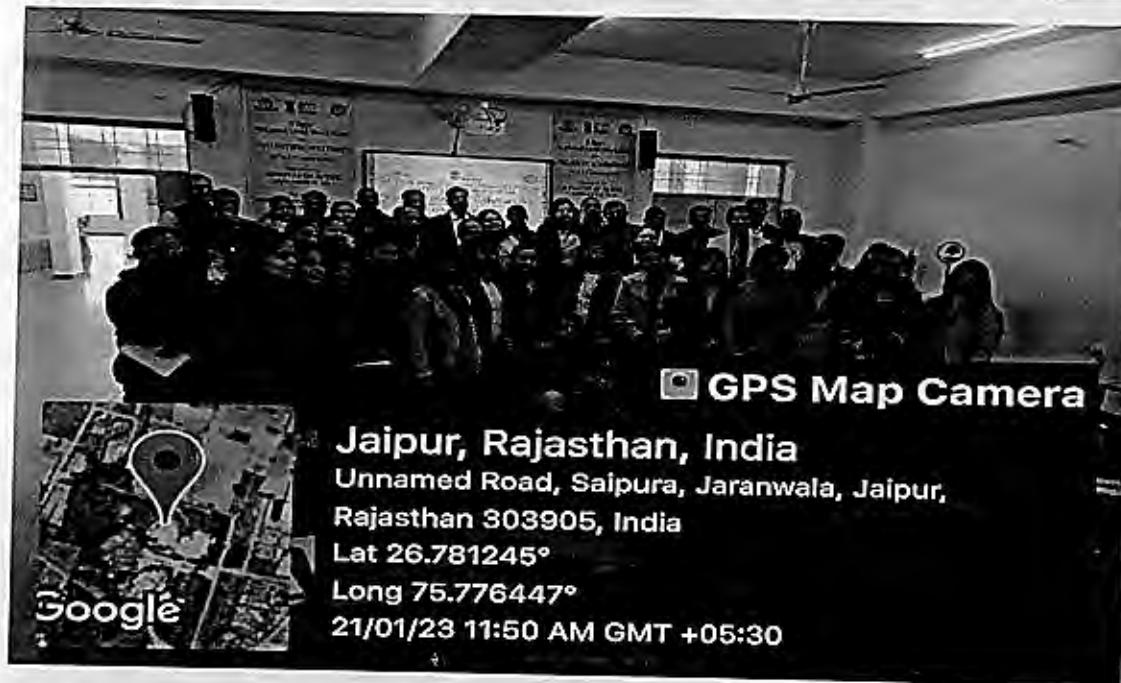
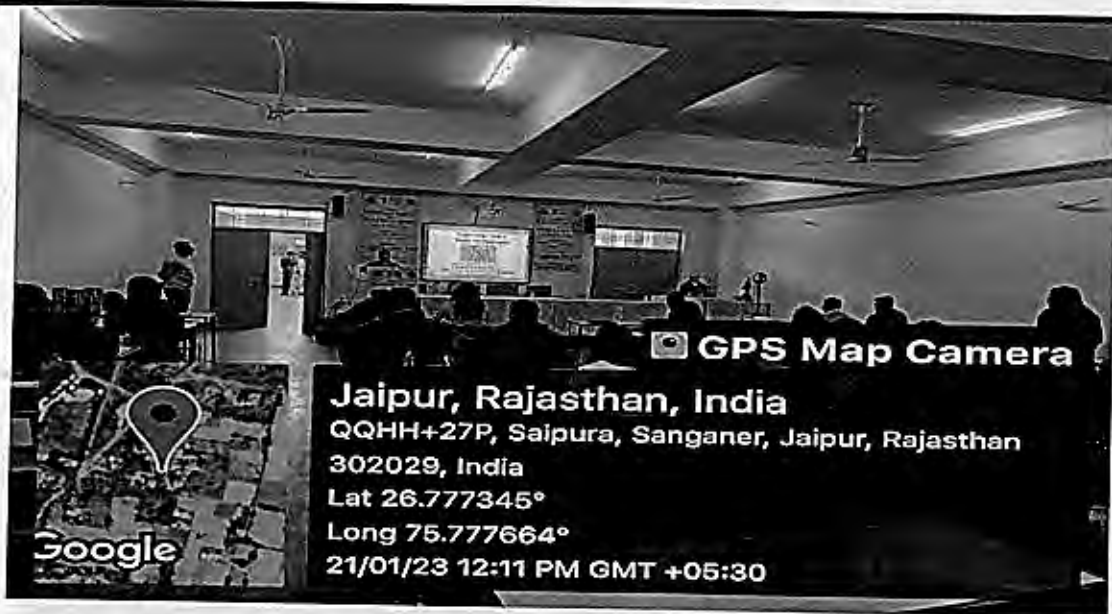

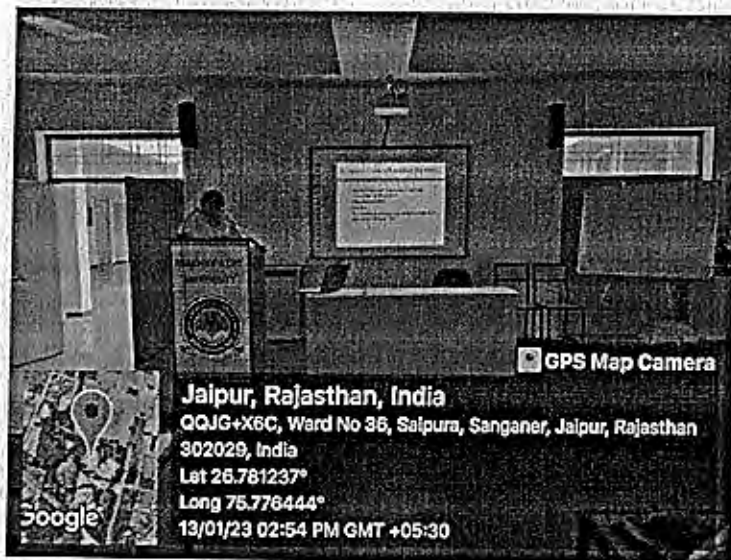


Dr. Kamlandra Tyagi elaborating about data presentation



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



Dr. Kamlandra Tyagi, HOD Dept of Obs & Gyn gave Introduction about Research that how it helps in solving the problems and provides service to society.



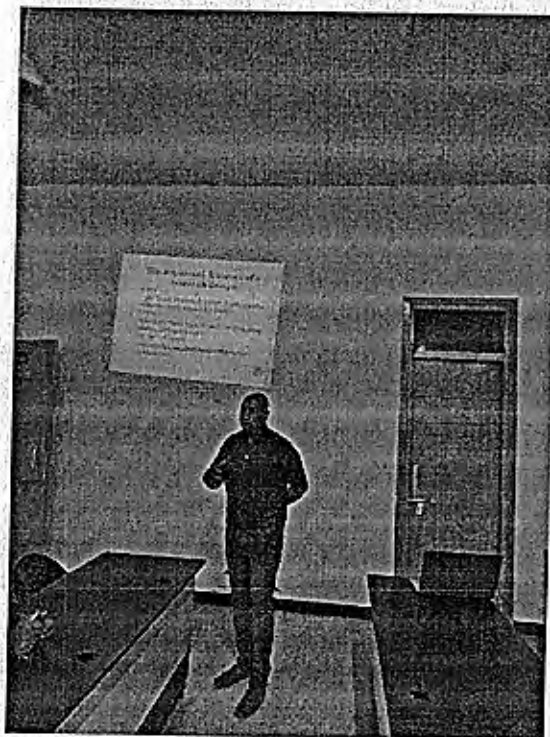

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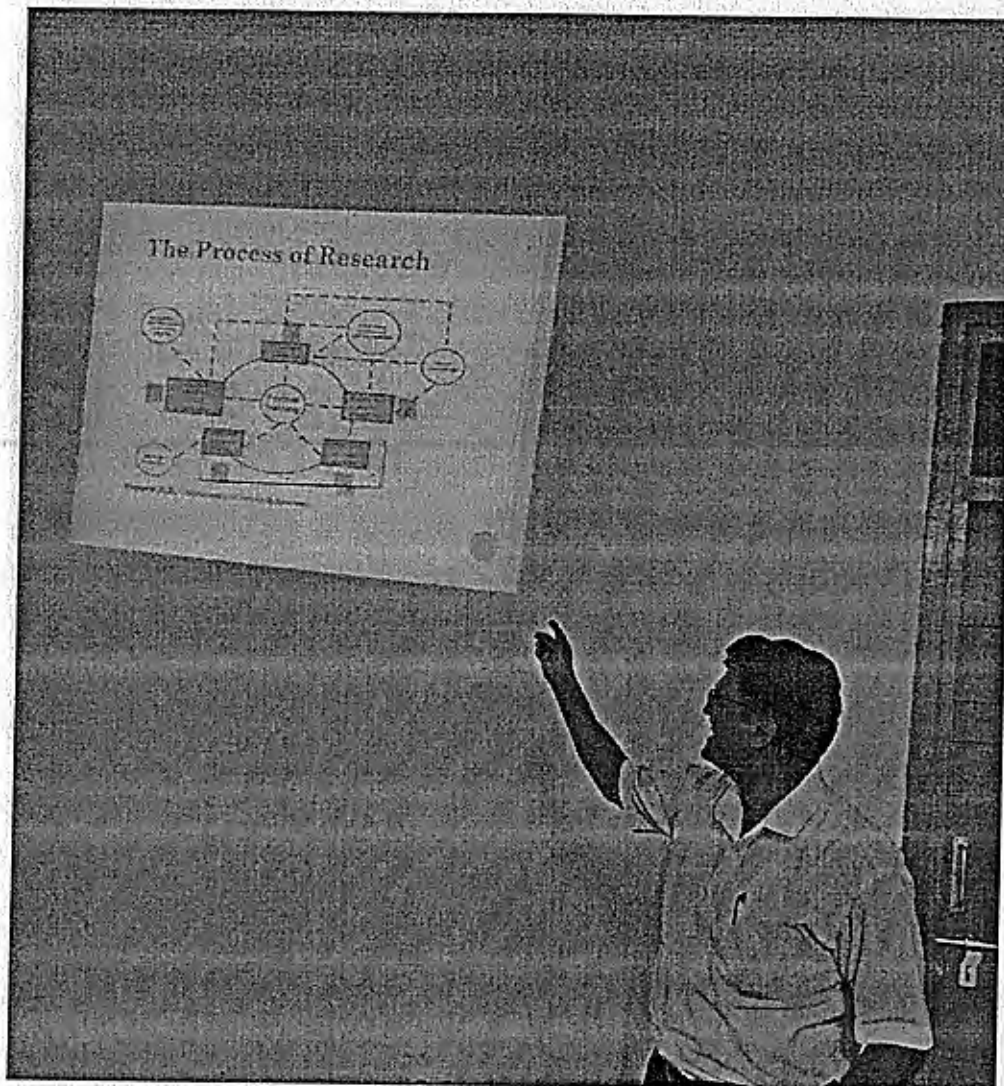


Dr Kamlandra explaining about the Research designing

ICH E6 (R2), also known as the "Guideline for Good Clinical Practice," is a key international guideline developed by the International Council for Harmonisation (ICH). It provides a comprehensive framework for the design, conduct, monitoring, and reporting of clinical trials.

Key features and updates in ICH E6 (R2) include:

1. Risk-Based Approach: The guideline emphasizes a risk-based approach to the management of clinical trials. It encourages sponsors to focus resources on areas with the highest potential risk to data integrity and participant safety.
2. Quality Management System (QMS): ICH E6 (R2) introduces the concept of a QMS, which includes written procedures, processes, and systems designed to ensure trial quality. The QMS should be implemented by the sponsor to monitor and improve the quality of the trial throughout its lifecycle.

  
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3. **Investigator Responsibilities:** The guideline outlines the responsibilities of investigators in conducting clinical trials, including obtaining informed consent from participants, ensuring compliance with the protocol, and reporting adverse events accurately and promptly.
4. **Essential Documents:** ICH E6 (R2) provides a list of essential documents that should be maintained for each clinical trial. These documents include the protocol, investigator's brochure, informed consent forms, and documentation of trial conduct and monitoring.
5. **Data Integrity:** The guideline emphasizes the importance of data integrity throughout the trial process. It requires sponsors to establish systems to ensure the accuracy, completeness, and reliability of trial data.
6. **Oversight of Clinical Trials:** ICH E6 (R2) stresses the importance of monitoring and oversight of clinical trials. It highlights the need for monitoring plans and processes to ensure that the trial is conducted in compliance with the protocol, applicable regulations, and GCP.
7. **Electronic Records and Electronic Signatures:** The guideline provides recommendations for the use of electronic records and electronic signatures in clinical trials, including their acceptance by regulatory authorities.

ICH E6 (R2) is considered a global standard for good clinical practice and is widely adopted by regulatory authorities, sponsors, and investigators involved in clinical research. Its implementation promotes the protection of participant rights, data integrity, and overall trial quality. It is important for stakeholders in clinical trials to be familiar with the provisions of ICH E6 (R2) and ensure compliance with its guidelines throughout the trial lifecycle.

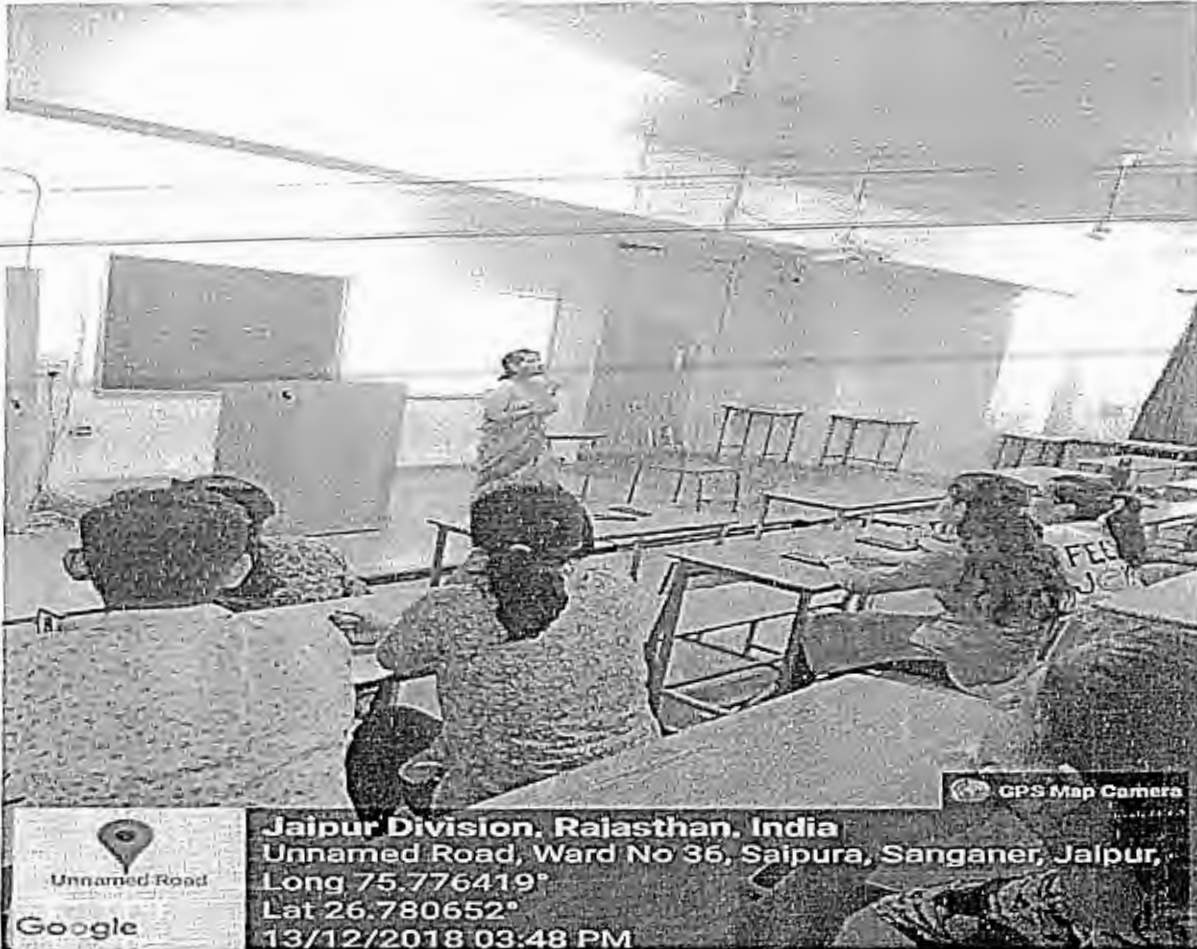



1. The manner in which it has been utilized :-

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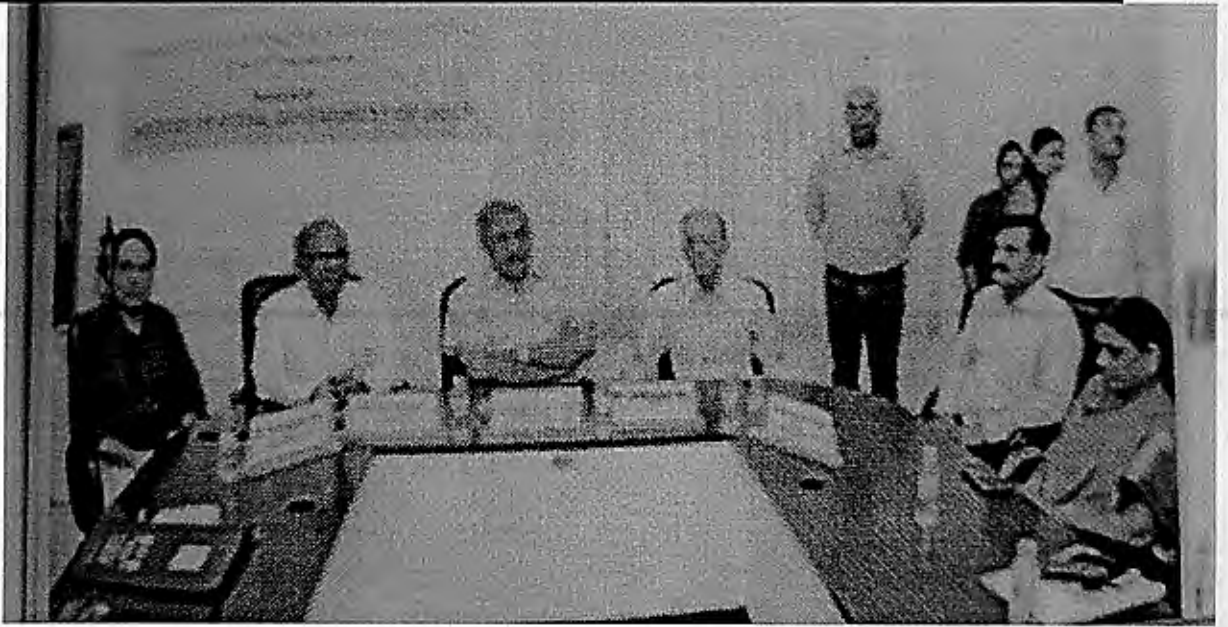
